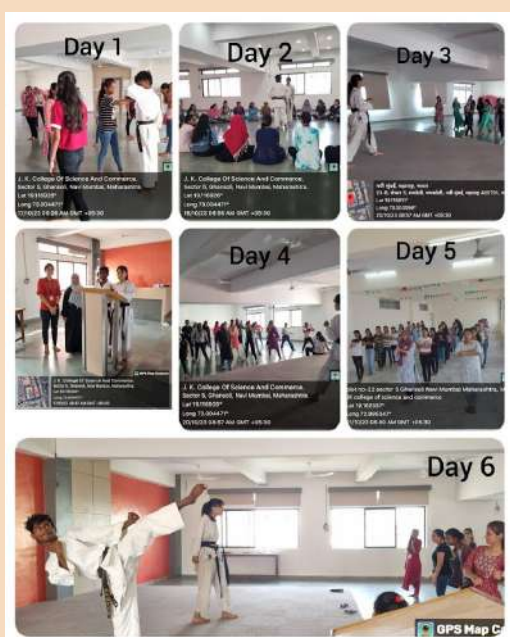
WOMEN DEVELOPMENT CELL

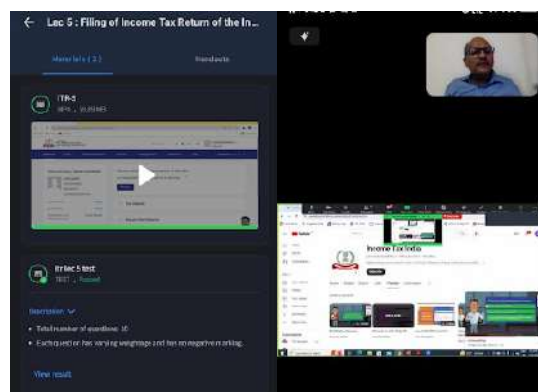
Centre For Skill Development

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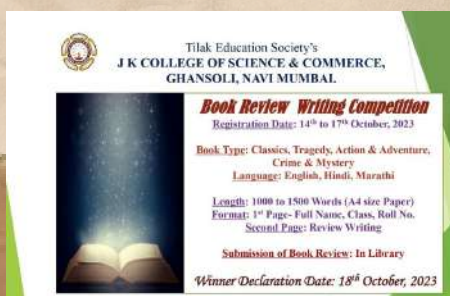
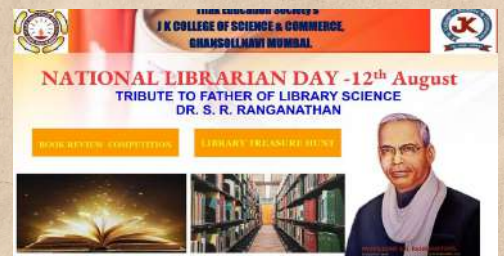
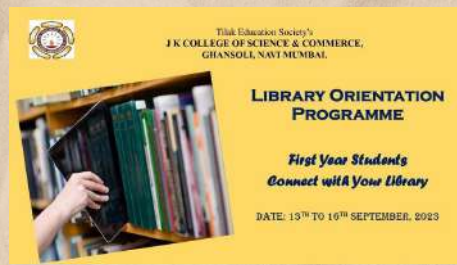

Inter-Collegiate Fest: Avahan '24

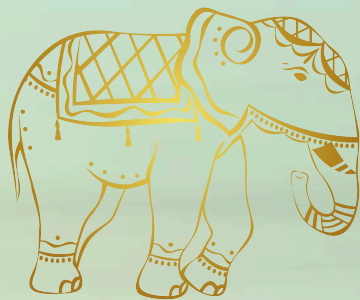

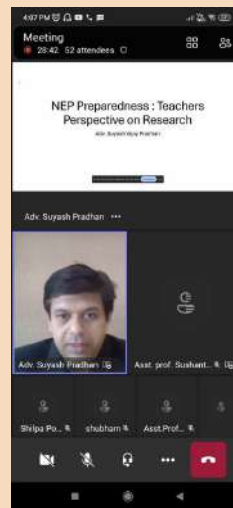


Research Development Cell
